Arena Wayfinding Signage

KMA Design of Carnegie, Pennsylvania, designed new signage and wayfinding for Consol Energy Center, home of the NHL's Pittsburgh Penguins. The KMA team formed directional, directories, regulation signage, as well as a new branding system for the Penguins.

Fabrication was completed by **L&H Sign Company**, based out of Philadelphia. The firms crafted the signage by using custom blackened steel, custom acrylic pattern to replicate ice, and horizontal details of brushed aluminum to resemble skate blades and also symbolize the three rivers Ohio, Allegheny and Monongahela.

The 18,500 seat, multi-tiered facility required numerous types of signage to guide visitors and identify the various amenities found on each level. The signage is a combination of flamed steel and cracked glass designed to emulate ice and denote the Pittsburgh area's steel heritage. In addition to the directional signage, KMA Design also implemented ADA compliant signs, retail and graphic enhancements for the arena.
